**AirPatrol WPM Product Enables Strict Enforcement
of New DoD Flash Drive Policies for Troops in Iraq and Afghanistan**

*AirPatrol's WPM Gives DoD IT Administrators Granular Realtime Control Over Which
USB Devices Can be Used by Individuals or Groups of Users*

Columbia, MD—March 9, 2010—AirPatrol Corporation, a leader in wireless threat management solutions, today announced its WPM product now supports the US Department of Defense's (DoD) updated Flash Drive Policy for military personnel, including troops in Iraq and Afghanistan. AirPatrol WPM enforces the policy by allowing DoD IT administrators to selectively block which USB devices can be used by individuals or groups of individuals.

The DoD banned use of flash drives and removable media devices in 2008 because of concerns over viruses, malware and other malicious programs infecting military networks. Last month, the U.S. Strategic Command (STRATCOM) announced "a limited return to use of memory sticks and thumb drives" for military personnel only, after a lengthy review of how the flash drives can be used without making networks susceptible to hackers. The drives will not be allowed on non-military networks and personal thumb drives, memory sticks, camera flash memory cards or portable mp3 players will not be allowed. WPM gives the granular control necessary to enforce this critical security policy.

"Maintaining balance between strict security and an open, free-flowing productive workforce has been a challenge facing IT administrators for decades. By supporting the DoD's updated flash drive policy, AirPatrol ensures that our current and future DoD customers are able to strictly enforce their security policies relating to government issued flash drives," said Ozzie Diaz, CEO, AirPatrol Corporation.

WPM is available in two versions – a native AirPatrol version, and a version compatible with McAfee e-Policy Orchestrator (ePO), for which AirPatrol was awarded the prestigious McAfee, Inc.
