**AirPatrol Demonstrates Product That Locates Contraband Cell Phones
in Maryland Correctional Facility**

*Prison Officials From Several States Receive First Hand Look at AirPatrol's
Wireless Locator System*

Columbia, MD—September 9, 2009—AirPatrol Corporation, a leading wireless threat management solutions company, demonstrated its innovative **Wireless Locator System (WLS)** to corrections officials from Maryland and several other states on September 3. WLS is an optimal solution to the contraband cell phone problem plaguing correctional facilities across the nation. The demonstration took place at the closed Maryland House of Corrections in Jessup, Maryland.

WLS is used to yield 24 x 7, real-time **cell phone and Wi-Fi device location details** throughout a correctional facility. The system addresses the contraband cell phone issue by giving correctional officers an intuitive, graphical display of the locations of active cellular and Wi-Fi devices within their secure areas. Unlike RF jamming techniques, it is completely legal and approved for use in the United States and abroad. Also, WLS does not interfere with authorized, legitimate cell phone usage or with authorized two-way radio usage.

In addition to the accurate detection and locating capabilities of WLS, AirPatrol demonstrated several of the product's features, including archiving and automated alerts and its WLS Forensic Database application. The WLS Forensic Database application gives correctional officers the ability to replay WLS graphical displays to view details about unauthorized cellular events which occurred in the past, including phone locations, call type, call frequency, start and stop times of voice calls, emails, text messages or data transfers.

“AirPatrol works with government agencies on the state and federal level to secure wireless communications and we appreciated the opportunity to demonstrate to Maryland and regional corrections officials how the Wireless Locator System is an ideal product for rooting out contraband cell phones,” said Ozzie Diaz, CEO, AirPatrol Corporation. “Detecting and removing contraband cell phones eliminates the risks associated with signal jamming equipment and enables 911 or everyday conversations to continue without disruption.”
